### Renovation

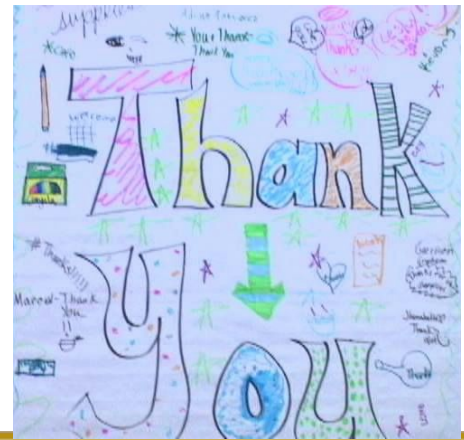
FAEA has adopted over **12 schools** by funding renovation projects in Nigeria.
